## Intro of the Five Love Languages – Part I of VII

1. Words of Affirmation
2. Quality Time
3. Receiving Gifts
4. Acts of Service
5. Physical Touch

## Words of Affirmation – Part II of VII

Words of Affirmation mean speaking words that build up.

*The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit. Proverbs 18:2*

## Quality Time – Part III of VII

Quality time means giving the other person your undivided attention.

*Then, because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat, He said to them, “Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest.” Mark 6:31*

## Receiving -- Gifts – Part IV of VII

A gift is a \_\_\_\_\_ of love.
