## The Five Love Languages

1. Words of Affirmation - words that build up

*The tongue has the power of life and death,  
and those who love it will eat its fruit.*

Prov. 18:2

*“Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place  
and get some rest.” Mark 6:31*

3. Receiving Gifts – a visible sign of love

*A generous man will prosper; he who  
refreshes others will himself be refreshed. Prov.  
11:25*

## Acts of Service - Part IV of VII

John 13:1-17, p. 1673

*Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet,  
you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an  
example that you should do as I have done for you. John  
13:14-15*

### Barriers:

2. **lack of** \_\_\_\_\_

Good understanding wins favor. Proverbs 13:15

3. **not having a servant's** \_\_\_\_\_

*...so he got up from the meal...and wrapped a towel  
around his waist...and began to wash his disciples'
