JESUS SPEAKS OUR LOVE LANGUAGE

Hebrews 12:1-3, p. 1877

Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (2)

1. **Words of Affirmation** – words that build up

Example: _____

When the Angel of the Lord appeared to Gideon, He said, “The Lord is with you, mighty warrior.” Judges 6:12

2. **Quality Time** – giving your undivided attention

Example: _____

The Lord said to Moses...Be ready in the morning, and then come up on Mount Sinai. Present yourself to me there on top of the mountain. Exodus 34:1-3

3. **Receiving Gifts** – a visible sign of love

Example: _____

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

4. **Acts of Service** – actions speak louder than words

Example: _____

He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. Mark 8:31

5. **Physical Touch** – a way to communicate love

Example: _____
